Preparing For the First Day of Camp!

You'll receive a full packet of information in the beginning of June. It includes things like what to wear to camp, how we prepare for emergencies, how to schedule makeup days and so much more. We also want to encourage you to mark your calendar and meet your bus staff on the Saturday morning prior to camp: June 17th. This brief meeting provides all campers with an opportunity to meet their bus counselors prior to the first day of camp.

New this year: Staff members will only be at their bus stops on the Saturday prior to Session One. There will not be a second Saturday meeting as there has been in the past.

 Meet your bus counselors at your bus stop. Specific times for each stop will be sent at the beginning of June.


Where else can you get elementary and middle school children to 'unplug' and thank you for it?
