MEETING CAMPER NEEDS



We know that campers are most able to grow when they feel physically and emotionally safe. From modelling respect and inclusion to taking frequent water and sunscreen breaks, our staff puts camper needs first.

HONORING VOICE & CHOICE



Research shows that children are more engaged in an activity when they have a say in what they are doing. Our counselors encourage and support camper-directed choices, like what to name the group or how to change up games.

PRACTICING SOCIAL SKILLS



We want our campers to grow up to be empathetic adults with strong relationship-building skills. Each camp group stays together all session so counselors can guide campers through meeting new friends and getting along with others.

COACHING RESPONSIBILITY



Campers learn to take responsibility for themselves every day, whether they're cleaning up at Arts & Crafts, carrying their own swim bag up to the pool, or making choices guided by our four central camp rules.

EMBRACING TEAMWORK
