

# IMPORTANT CAMP NEWS FOR THIS FRIDAY

Answers to frequently asked questions and some tips to make *The Great Kinneret Sleepout II* a success!

# MY CAMPER(S) <u>WILL BE</u> COMING HOME FROM CAMP THIS FRIDAY, BECAUSE THEY ARE NOT GOING TO THE SLEEPOUT – WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

<u>Please bring your ID to your bus stop on Friday afternoon.</u> While our regular afternoon bus routes will take campers to their normal bus stops on the usual schedule, <u>many buses will have a different bus counselor</u> to sign campers out at the stops. Help make this process run smoothly by having your ID in hand at your stop.

### **VISITING CAMP THIS FRIDAY**

PLEASE DON'T VISIT CAMP THIS FRIDAY. Sleepout Fridays are the one day that we ask parents not to visit camp because it is an especially busy, high energy day at camp. While it is a regular camp day, we have found that it's not a good day for families to try to visit their campers at camp. Because of this, we want to remind you to please choose any day other than Sleepout Friday to visit camp. If you haven't visited yet, it is a great way to help connect with your camper's experience. Pick a day, put on your shorts and tennis shoes and come play with us!

## **SLEEPOUT INFORMATION**

Campers attending the Sleepout but not attending camp on Friday should be brought to camp between 3:00 and 3:45 on Friday afternoon. Please bring your Sleepout gear with you when you bring them on Friday.

#### WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW - BRIEF REMINDERS

- 1. What to bring? If your campers are staying for the Sleepout this Friday, they should bring all of their items to camp in a garbage bag or duffel bag. Please see the back of this sheet for a full list of what to pack!
- 2. Label everything with your camper's name, his or her counselor's name and bus stop (letter and number).
- 3. Can we visit during the Sleepout? The Sleepout is a wonderful and exciting tradition at camp. Campers of all ages enjoy the food, entertainment and sleeping under the stars. It is very normal for campers to be excited and even nervous before the Sleepout and this week's staff meeting focuses on preparing our staff for this special evening with our campers. To attend the Sleepout, campers need to be prepared to spend the night without seeing their parents from the time they arrive at camp on Friday until the following morning. It is our experience that once campers are at camp and involved in the fun of the night, visits from parents lead to separation anxiety. It is for this reason that campers (and families) need to be prepared to say "see you in the morning" when they say their Friday goodbyes.
- 4. How is my camper doing? If you are concerned about how your camper is doing during the evening, rest assured that if they decide that they would rather not spend the night, we will work with them to try to have a successful night. If it turns out that they aren't quite ready, we'll give you a call (at any hour) and encourage them to try another Sleepout as soon as they feel ready.

#### SATURDAY MORNING...

- A. I indicated that I will pick my camper up at camp. What time should I be there? Please plan to be at camp at 10:00am to pick up campers. (Directions to camp: 101 to Kanan Rd. Go South on Kanan Rd. towards the beach. Turn right on Agoura Rd. We're about ½ mile down on the left.)
- B. My camper will be riding a bus home. What time will she/he arrive at the bus stop? Please see the back for Saturday morning bus stops and times.

#### WHAT YOUR CHILD WILL NEED FOR THE GREAT KINNERET SLEEPOUT II:

1. SLEEPING BAG All of our campers and staff sleep outside on the grass. Even during warm summer days, the

nights here at camp can be quite cold. It is important to send an outdoor type sleeping bag that will provide warmth for your child. (Typically a light weight cloth sleeping bag does <u>not</u> keep children

warm enough when spending the night outdoors.)

2. JACKET A very warm sweatshirt also works; it can get chilly and it's nice to have warm clothes to wear

and even to sleep in. (We sleep in our clothes too.)

3. LONG PANTS Sweat pants are a great option, but all campers should bring 1 pair of long pants for the

evening. (If your camper is attending a regular camp day Friday, these are best packed in their camp

backpack for easy access.)

4. FLASHLIGHT It does get dark and flashlights sure help us find our sleeping bags after the campfire. They also

help light the path to the bathrooms. (Be sure to write your name on it!)

**5. TOILETRIES** Toothbrush, toothpaste, or any other necessary toiletry articles.

**6. A SMILE** The Great Kinneret Sleepout is FUN!!!

7. EXTRA TOWEL Campers entering 1st grade and above will swim again in the late afternoon. If we've been in camp

all day, we like to have a dry bathing suit and towel for our second swim!

(If your camper is attending a regular camp day Friday, these are best packed in their camp backpack

for easy access.)
