### SLEEPOUT DEADLINE EXTENDED!!

The Great Kinneret Sleepout II is this Friday night!!! It will be another great night of fun. Because we received so many calls to add the Sleepout at the end of last week, **we have extended the Sleepout sign-up deadline through this Tuesday, August 7<sup>th</sup>**. You may submit your online registration as late as midnight on the 7<sup>th</sup>.

### SLEEPOUT CAMPERS WHO ARE NOT HERE ON FRIDAY

If your campers are attending the Sleepout but are not scheduled to be at camp on Friday, please bring them and their gear to camp between 3:00 pm and 3:45 pm Friday afternoon. During this time and until our buses depart, you will be directed into the lower parking lot to avoid conflict with our buses that will be loading to take campers home at the end of the regular Friday program. Please plan to "drop and go" and we will escort arriving campers to their groups!

### FRIDAY CAMPERS WHO ARE NOT STAYING FOR SLEEPOUT

Campers who are not attending the Sleepout will return to their regular bus stops at their regular end of day times. There will be many fewer campers on board each bus, but your regular driver and bus will bring your camper back from camp. Most of our staff will be remaining in camp for the Sleepout. **In most cases your Friday afternoon bus counselor will be someone other than your regular bus counselor so please have your ID with you and in your hands when you go to the stop in the afternoon.**

**REMINDER:** Sleepout Friday is a busy day at camp and we ask that parents not visit camp on this day. Thank you!

### CARNIVAL DAY

Next Tuesday, August 14<sup>th</sup> is our annual Camp Kinneret Carnival. There are no roller coasters or rides, but even better: there are booths and games created by none other than Camp Kinneret campers. Campers not regularly scheduled for that day may schedule a makeup or extra day for the day. Just call the office to see if we have space! If you'd prefer, you can bring them for just the carnival in the afternoon. Drop them off at **12:45 pm** and pick them up **between 2:15 and 2:30 pm**. Our staff will be waiting by the barricade to sign them in & out. *(Please note that campers who come only for the carnival in the afternoon must be picked up at camp and are not scheduled to ride the bus home).*

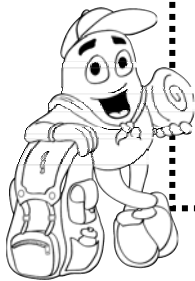
## Saturday Morning Pickup

## Sleepout Gear: What to pack!

Pack your camper's gear in 1 large duffle bag or trash bag. Label everything with your camper's name, his or her counselor's name and bus stop (letter and number).

- 1. SLEEPING BAG:** All of our campers and staff sleep outside on the grass. Even during warm summer days, the nights here at camp can be quite cold. It is important to send an **outdoor type** sleeping bag that will provide warmth for your child.
- 2. LONG PANTS & JACKET (or a very warm sweatshirt):** It can get chilly and it's nice to have warm clothes to wear and even to sleep in. *(We sleep in our clothes too!)*
- 3. FLASHLIGHT:** It does get dark and flashlights sure help us find our sleeping bags after the campfire and help light the path to the bathrooms. *(Be sure to write your camper's name on it!)*
- 4. TOILETRIES:** Feel free to pack a toothbrush, toothpaste, and any other items your camper may need.
- 5. EXTRA TOWEL & SWIM SUIT:** Campers entering 1<sup>st</sup> grade and above only.
- 6. A SMILE:** The Sleepout is FUN!!!
