FORGOTTEN WATER BOTTLES AT HOME?

Be assured that we have lots of disposable water bottles here at camp to ensure all campers are staying hydrated, even if they forget their bottles at home! During our morning assembly each counselor is checking to make sure each of their campers has a bottle for the day. If not, their Leadership Team person will bring a disposable bottle for the camper to use. Each disposable bottle costs \$1 which will automatically be charged to your account if your camper forgets their bottle for the day.

LABEL YOUR CAMPERS' ITEMS!

We have had a great start with keeping our lost and (not) found to a minimum so far! Please continue to ensure that your camper's items are labeled with their full names to help us match lost items with their owners before they go home for the day. If you are missing items, please let us know and we'll ask your camper's counselors to help them look for it.

Most importantly, we want to make sure that we're not mixing up our water bottles with other campers! Please make sure your water bottles are labeled and re-label them as the labels wash off.
