- Please continue to send your camper with a backpack, swimsuit, towel, and lunch every day.
- We will continue to capture each group in our posted camp photos!

WHEREABOUTS APP

The Whereabouts app is now live for Week 9! Please continue to use it to report your campers' absences and change their afternoon transportation. Don't forget to check out camp photos and lost and found there as well!

BUS STOP CHANGES

DROP OFF & PICK UP AT CAMP - REMINDERS!

- **Only campers can enter the camp site.** Parents/guardians and siblings must be prepared to sign their camper in and say goodbye for the day. Visitors are not allowed into camp at any time during camp hours.
- **Drop off procedures:**
 - When arriving for drop off, please head to camp from the west (Reyes Adobe Road) so you can make a right turn into the camp driveway.

- If you need to drop your camper off late, please use the Whereabouts app or call the office to let us know. The main driveway will be closed from 9:00 to 10:00 but we may be able to accommodate drop off during that time.
- **Pick up procedures:**
 - As in the mornings, please head to camp from the west (Reyes Adobe Road) so you can make a right turn into the camp driveway.
 - Remember to always have your photo ID ready for sign-out. Some staff members will get to know you by sight throughout the session but that will take a few days, and there may be different staff people at sign-out from day to day.
 - The driveway will be closed and **sign-outs will not be permitted between 2:00 and 4:00 every day.**
 - If you need to pick up your camper early, it must be prior to 2:00. Use the Whereabouts app or call the office to let us know when we should have your camper ready for you!
- **Regular Drop Off/Pick Up Schedule:**
 - Camp-only drop off is between 8:45 - 9:00
 - Camp-only pick up is between 4:00 - 4:15
 - **Reminder:** Campers CANNOT be picked up between 2:00 - 4:00
 - *Campers not enrolled in Extended Care who are dropped off before 8:45 am or picked up after 4:15 pm will be charged \$20 the first time. The second time this occurs, the camper will be moved to the Extended Care program, and the full tuition rate will be applied.*
- **Extended Care Drop Off/Pick Up Schedule:**
 - Extended Care drop off is between 8:00 - 9:00
 - Extended Care pick up is between 4:00 - 5:00
 - **Reminder:** Campers CANNOT be picked up between 2:00 - 4:00
 - *Campers who are picked up after 5:00 pm will be charged a fee of \$2/min each time*

LOST & FOUND

We do our best to get labeled items back to their owners, but many of the things we find have no names. Items like bathing suits, goggles, and water bottles often go unclaimed. Please help us by clearly labeling your child's belongings with full names, and by updating those labels as they get worn off. If you ever realize your camper has brought home someone else's towel, t-shirt, or other item, please send it back to camp with your child and we will get it back to its owner. Unlabeled items are displayed at the Friendship Hill assembly every day so campers can claim the things that belong to them.

We've taken pictures of all of the unlabeled items that we've collected and post them through the Whereabouts app each week. IF you spot something that belongs to your camper, [click here](#) to claim it! items not claimed will be donated to charity in the fall.
